Over the years, India has been promoting children's rights as enshrined within the constitution and protected in our legislation in line with the UN Convention on the Rights of the Child" (adopted in 1989) as a government priority. It is imperative that the rights of these children are met and there are ample initiatives to safeguard the rights of children.

As the Member (Child Psychology & Sociology) of the National Commission for Protection of Child Rights, I have invested efforts to ensure all child laws, policies, programmes, and administrative mechanisms are in line with the child rights perspectives as enshrined in the constitution of India and the UN Convention on the Rights of the Child. During the course of my third year at the Commission, I have been focused in my approach to strengthen the state of child protection and health in India, with a special emphasis to improve the scenario of mental health care for vulnerable children. Thus, as I complete my tenure at the Commission, I have initiated and prioritized this vertical for achieving greater milestones in consonance with the vision that our Hon'ble Prime Minister Sh. Narendra Modiji aspires for the children of India. With the eminent direction of Smt. Smriti Z. Irani, Hon'ble Minister, Women and Child Development, I have made significant efforts to create greater access and outreach of mental health services

and remove formidable barrier for psycho-social care for vulnerable children.

Since the beginning of this tenure, I have envisaged for holistic well-being of children. As my 3 year term comes to an end, I have marked efforts for a greater investment in mental health and prevention of substance abuse in India. Especially, It is a matter of priority to act upon the concerns raised by the Hon'ble Prime Minister Shri Narendra Modi ji in respect to the menace of drugs and children falling into drug trap. Therefore, to wage a war against drugs and substance abuse among children, a joint action plan has been prepared to streamline and strategize the efforts made by various authorities, institutions, agencies to bring paradigm shifts in the direction of drugs and substance abuse prevention amongst the children in the country. This Joint Action Plan is envisaged as a framework to wean away children from drug abuse and to stop selling of drugs in surrounding areas of schools/educational and child care institutions through convergent actions in a timebound manner. It also adopts some of the strategic interventions to prevent the reach of pharmaceutical drugs, substances and other forms of goods used as intoxicants by the children.

Prominently, with an objective of providing psychologi-





cal first-aid and emotional support to children affected during COVID-19 pandemic, "SAMVEDNA" (Sensitizing Action on Mental Health Vulnerability through Emotional Development and Necessary Acceptance) - a toll-free, tele-counselling helpline for children, was launched by Commission to provide psycho-social mental support for children affected during COVID 19 Pandemic.

Furthermore, to strengthen the state of mental health for vulnerable child population, "SAHARA" (Supportive Action with Holistic Approach to build Resilience among the children of Armed Police Force personnel) was initiated with the objective to strive to link children of BSF personnel with the welfare scheme of Govt. of India and Border Security Force. It is aimed at providing emotional support, psycho-social first aid and counselling for the children. As per the mandate of the Commission under Section 13 (1) (j) of CPCR Act 2005, NCPCR experts will provide counselling, redress the grievances of children pertaining to violation and deprivation of their rights & entitlements, issues pertaining to education, health and other needs.

I would like to extend my gratitude and acknowledgment to Sh. Priyank Kanoongo, Chairperson, NCPCR for persistently supporting me in all my endeavours with a shared vision to strengthen the state of child protection in India. Together, with his support, we at the Commission carried out policy interventions, programme activities, created standard operating procedures and took up various inspections/inquires throughout my 3 year journey. We also stepped-up in the adverse times of Covid-19 and rigorously attended to the care and protection of children.

I would like to thank and acknowledge the continuous cooperation received from all the Members of the Commission Shri- Yaswant Jain (Laws Related to Children), Ms.Pragna Parande (Juvenile Justice), Ms.Rosy Taba (Child Labour) and Ms.Rupali Banerjee Singh, Member Secretary. We all have dedicatedly worked as one collective unit, and supported each other's mission and endeavour to uplift the state of child protection in India across the spectrum of juvenile justice, trafficking, substance abuse, education, child labour, child marriage, matters of POCSO, child health and their holistic well-being.

My heartfelt acknowledgement also goes to the State Commissions for Protection of Child Rights (SCPCRs) who are the counterparts of the NCPCR, and have been playing an enormous role in the area of child protection. They have immensely supported by joint ventures and field visits to the their respective states and have collaborated with me even in the time of adversity. Without their continuous and selfless support, I would have not been able to achieve the goal of ensuring rights of the children in the country for three consecutive years. Therefore, I would like to thank and appreciate all the Chairpersons & Members of State/UT CPCRs for their commitment towards the children of the country.

I convey my heartiest wishes to everyone at the Commission. I am certain the Commission has greater milestones to accomplish with the an encouraging spirit.

After 3 long years, I know much is yet to be achieved, and its impact yet to be translated to the most vulnerable and deprived children in India. Thus, I shall continue to be devoted in my service towards children guided by the philosophy of Sarvodaya by Gandhiji which means 'Universal Uplift' or 'Progress of All".

# **Chapter 4**

# Projects: New Initiatives (2020)

# 1 Training of Trainers Programme: First 5-day National ToT for Counsellors on Psychological Trauma Assessment & Intervention in Child Abuse

It has been widely documented that children experiencing physical, emotional and sexual abuse, undergo a squeal of adverse physical, behavioral and mental health consequences hampering overall development. The trauma often spills into their adulthood depending upon the type, severity of abuse and availability of support. Apart from causing a variety of psychopathology like PTSD and depression, the effects include fear, anger, hostility, guilt, shame, sleep disturbances an array of sexualized/sexually inappropriate behaviour (in case of CSA). And children from poor and vulnerable families are at higher risk of being abused at home, which could result in running away from home leading to even more risk of being abused by others. Such children when rescued and kept in CCIs need to be dealt with proper care and trauma assessment to prevent short-and long-term mental health risks and also for their all-round development. Thus, counsellors and CPOs at CCIs have a crucial role in not only dealing with immediate crisis management of the situation but overall working for the well-being of the children. Hence proper training of such professionals will create a cadre of trained manpower percolating down till the CCIs level.



The aim of the programme was to create a cadre of trained counsellor/child protection officers on this subject at state level, so that knowledge and awareness percolate down till the CCI level directly.

A total number of 24 participants (mean age 32.95 years) from 10 states/UTs attended the programme. A majority of these participants had exhibited good participatory skills and showed high level of interest to take up the programme at a regional and state level, as a result of which the first state level training of trainers programme is now planned to be organised at DCPCR, Delhi. The programme design was based on the relevant topics identified during the 1st National Conclave on Psychological Trauma, Child Protection, and Mental Illness held in March 2018 at AIIMS, New Delhi. The conclave was attended by 400 participants from various parts of India, Nepal, Bangladesh, and Sri Lanka. The methodology of delivering various contents included lecture through power point presentation, group discussion, group activity, role play, demonstration, observation, psychological games, and interactive bilateral mode of subject delivery.

# 2 Joint Action Plan:Prevention of Drugs and Substance Abuse among Children and Illicit Trafficking. "Ek Yudh Nashe Ke Virudh"

This "Joint Action Plan on Prevention of Drugs and Substance Abuse among Children and Illicit Trafficking" is a framework to:

- 1. Wean away children from using drugs and substances.
- 2.Stop selling drugs and substances in surroundings areas of schools and other educational institutes through enforcement of existing laws.
- 3. Provide coverage of various existing schemes, programmes and policies for treatment and rehabilitation of children using drugs and substances.
- 4. Highlight the roles and responsibilities as well as strengthen the capacity of various stakeholders in prevention of drugs and substance use among children and its illicit trafficking.
- 5. Increase awareness and replicate best practices.
- 6.Increase surveillance in areas around schools, educational institutions and pharmacies to ensure the drugs and substances are not reaching the children.
- 7.Strengthen and ensure enforcement of legal provisions provided under different laws in respect to selling drugs and substances to the children, use of children in trafficking drugs
- 8. Adopt zero tolerance policy on drug and substance abuse among children through integrated efforts of all stakeholders in a convergent manner.

## The core principles/strategies adopted in the JAP are as follows:

- 1. Convergent action by all concerned authorities and service providers.
- 2. Making provisions for services/facilities wherever necessary.
- 3. Time-bound implementation of the action plan.
- 4. Concurrent monitoring of all the interventions.
- 5. Strict enforcement of legal provisions.

The important components of the Joint Action Plan are: provision of Prahari Clubs, wherein, children would be oriented on Gandhian Principles. The members of the Prahari Clubs would ensure no drugs and substances in and around school premises, Awareness generation, Management Information System (MIS) for the manufacturing, supply and retail sales of H, H1, and X drugs, appropriate mechanism to prevent the sales of liquor, tobacco and substances in nearby schools. Moreover, this Joint Action Plan is envisaged as a framework to wean away children from drug abuse and to stop selling of drugs in surrounding areas of schools/educational and child care institutions through convergent actions in a time-bound manner.

Since it is an initiative of convergent action, all the authorities, duty bearers and stakeholders such as Narcotics Control Bureau (NCBs), SCPCRs, Excise Department, Ministry of Health, Ministry of Social Justice & Empowerment, Ministry of Education, Central Drugs Standard Control Organization (CDSCO), Gandhi Smriti & Darshan Samiti, NCERT, Police, District Magistrate, Child Welfare Police Officer, and others have been given their designated roles in the implementation of the Action Plan Formulation of this Joint Action Plan is a step toward fulfilling the vision of Mahatma Gandhi and addressing the concerns raised by the Hon'ble Prime Minister regarding the menace of drugs to make a drugs-free India (Nasha Mukt Bharat) so that the vision of New India can be fulfilled.

## Background

Thousands of children whose parents laid down their lives in the line of duty for the country face an uncertain situation dominated by trauma and potentially exposing them to varying degrees of symptoms of post-traumatic stress disorder (PTSD) and depression in the future. Loss of parent in the attack may result in the feeling of denial and anger and may further lead to grave psychological manifestations of grief and trauma. Thus, they are placed at a major risk of developing major mental health-related problems, which are otherwise left unnoticed and unattended by them and their family members. This further implies that children of martyrs are one of the most vulnerable child populations neglected of immediate psycho-social care and support. Against the purview of this deplorable scenario, it is pertinent to ensure outreach and accessibility of psycho-social support and counselling, given the impoverished state of mental health services available for this vulnerable child population. Thus, in light of Section 13 (1) (e) of The Commissions for Protection of Child Rights Act (CPCR), 2005 the Division of Child Psychology and Sociology, National Commission for Protection of Child Rights started a tele counseling service on Toll free Number 18001-236-236 named SAHARA.

## **SAHARA**

Supportive Action with Holistic Approach to build Resilience among the children of Armed Forces Personnel

This service is for the children for their psychological, educational, health and socio-emotional support and to provide assistance to link children with the welfare schemes of Armed Forces.

- 1. Sh Rakesh Asthana, Director General, Border Security Force along with Sh Priyank Kanoongo, Chairperson, National Commission for Protection of Child Rights (NCPCR) today launched 'SAHARA', an exclusive Toll Free Tele Counselling number 1800-1-236-236 and Weblink for children of BSF personnel who have laid down their lives in the line of duty.
- 2. SAHARA is aimed at providing emotional support, Psycho-Social first aid and counselling for the children, and this facility will be functional from 10 AM to 5 PM (Monday to Friday). As per the mandate of the Commission under Section 13 (1) (j) of CPCR Act 2005, NCPCR experts will provide counselling, redress the grievances of children pertaining to violation and deprivation of their rights & entitlements, issues pertaining to education, health and other needs.
- 3. NCPCR will also be coordinating through respective State Commissions to address the issues faced by children of deceased BSF personnel, who are located in the remote corners of the country.
- 4. SAHARA (Supportive Action with Holistic Approach to build Resilience among the children of Armed Police Force personnel) will strive to link children of BSF personnel with the welfare scheme of Govt. of India and BSF.
- 5. State Commissions for Protection of Child Rights of all the States/UTs and BSF personnel from all the States joined the programme virtually.

With an objective of providing psychological first-aid and emotional support to children affected during COVID-19 Pandemic, National Commission for Protection of Child Rights (NCPCR) is providing Tele-Counselling to children through SAMVEDNA (Sensitizing Action on Mental Health Vulnerability through Emotional Development and Necessary Acceptance) - a Toll-Free Helpline launched to provide psycho-social mental support for Children affected during COVID-19 Pandemic. Tele-counselling is being provided through a network of qualified Experts/Counselors/Psychologists trained under the guidance of Dr. Shekhar Seshadri, Professor, Department of Child and Adolescent Psychiatry and his team from NIMHANS, on various psychosocial issues in reference to COVID-19, using different Tele counselling strategies.

SAMVEDNA, tele counselling service is for psychological support to children to address their stress, anxiety, fear and other issues during the Pandemic. This service is available on a toll-free No: 1800-121-2830 from Monday to Saturday from 10 a.m. to 1 p.m. and 3 p.m. to 8 p.m. This service is exclusively for children who are willing to talk and need counseling. When a child/ caretaker/Parent dials SAMVEDNA1800-121-2830, they get to speak to a professional counselor in a safe environment. Tele counselling is provided to the children under three categories:

- 1. Children who are in Quarantine/isolation/COVID Care centers.
- 2. Children who have COVID positive parents or family members and near ones.
- 3. Children who have lost their parents due to Covid-19 Pandemic.

This Toll-free Tele-Counselling cater to the children from all over India in various regional languages like Tamil, Telugu, Kannada, Oriya, Marathi, Gujarati, Bengali etc. This service was launched in September, 2020 and continuing to support children in the difficult times of COVID-19 pandemic.




